Host city - Stare Jabłonki, Poland

Warmia and Masuria is a land of adventure and leisure. Before your eyes, one of Europe's most beautiful landscapes extends here. Thousands of years before this terrain has been shaped by a glacier, which created the hills and hillocks intertwined with thousands of lakes, pools and ponds. These were surrounded by woods and forests, the kingdom of animals and birds. Thanks to these woods and forests the North-Eastern region of the country was called the green lungs of Poland and in the competition for 7 New Wonders of the World Masuria was placed among the 14 most attractive places on the Earth.

Warmia and Mazury region is distinguished by a rich cultural heritage. The architecture, art, science, crafts and trade have been developing here for centuries. The medieval castles form one of the most beautiful tourist routes in the country - Gothic Castles Route. The medieval churches, monasteries, pilgrims' churches and roadside shrines created in the catholic Warmia are of unique architectural and artistic value. A wide range of urban and recreation facilities attracts a number of tourists in the summertime.

The festivals of music, cabaret and culinary, the reconstructions of battles, air shows, sailing races, kayaking and sailing cruises have been increasingly popular for many years. When twenty years ago, on the beach in Stare Jablonki first lorries brought sand, even the greatest optimist did not dream that this small Masurian village would host the greatest sportsmen in the world at the sporting events of the highest rank.

The first event organised on the beach of the Anders Hotel was Olsztynskie Voivodeship Championships, which seemed to be a great challenge back then. As we can see, a dozen or so years of consequent work, persistence and certainly a luck can lead to such an extraordinary final – ebt Final.

The venue in Stare Jablonki is one of the few in the world to have all the necessities in one place. All Beach Handball facilities, accommodation and restaurants and the main courts are located on the beach of the lake Szelag Maly. You will find here: 1 main court, 1 side court, 1 warm-up court, and grandstands for over 2500 people and space for over 2,000 people around the side courts. It's all in!

for delegate candidates	Beach Handball experience / involvement in national Beach Handball activities Under 45 years of age English as a foreign language is obligatory Female delegates are very welcome Nominations of federations which have no beach handball delegates have priority

Basic requirements / tests

- Referees: Health confirmation obligatory (not older than 2 months) – physical test on 30 May 2018.
- Referees and Delegates: Beach handball – Rules of the Game 4th Edition – see ebt website www.ebt.eurohandball.com – rules tests on 29 and 30 May 2018.
- Delegates: European Championship Regulations for beach handball and the official EHF beach handball match report (on request available via the EHF Office) – test on regulations on 30 May 2018.
- Coaches: Basic and advanced knowledge on beach handball techniques, playing and substitution strategies.

Special offer for female referees / delegates / coaches

The EHF supports the registration of female referees / delegates / coaches by bearing the travel costs for max. 1 female referee pair, 2 female delegates and 2 female coaches (following the “first come – first served” basis). Remember: Only 8 referee pairs / 8 delegates / 10 coaches can participate in total!

Course fee	€300 (will be borne by the EHF; in case of late withdrawal the course fee has to be paid – see registration form)
Travel	All participants* have to organise the travel and to pay the travel expenses themselves (*except max. one female referee pair, max. two female delegates and max. two female coaches).
Transfer	Will be organised by the organiser free of charge for referees and delegates; coaches have to bear the transfer costs by themselves.
Accommodation	For referees and delegates the organiser will bear the costs for accommodation during the course. The coaches have to bear the accommodation costs themselves, see www.ebtfinals2018.com .
Payment	To be jointly agreed with the POL organiser.
Course follow-up	Course documentation, certificate on successful attendance and information to the respective National Federation, EHF status of Beach Handball referee / delegate / coach.
