# EHF Beach Handball Commission

The EHF Beach Handball Commission (BC) is an initiator of projects in order to develop beach handball as an independent sport discipline within the European Handball family. One of the main targets of the BC is the education of facilitators in all member federations. Combined educational courses for referees, delegates and coaches have been organised since 1999.

## Pre-condition for all participants: Completion of a national beach handball course

| for delegate candidates        | Beach handball experience / involvement in national beach handball activities<br>Under 45 years of age<br>Good English knowledge (both written and spoken)<br>Nominations of federations which have no beach handball delegates and female delegates have priority |

### Basic requirements / tests

- All course participants: Rules of the Game 4<sup>th</sup> Edition for beach handball – see ebt website [www.ebt.eurohandball.com](http://www.ebt.eurohandball.com).
- Referees: Health confirmation obligatory (not older than 2 months) – physical test on 22 July
- Delegates: European Championship regulations for beach handball and the official EHF beach handball match report (will be made available in due time before the course).
- Coaches: Basic and advanced knowledge on beach handball techniques, playing and substitution strategies.

### Support for female candidates through the EHF Women’s Handball Board\*:

The EHF WHB supports the participation of female referees / delegates / coaches by bearing the travel costs for max. 1 female referee pair, 2 female delegates and 2 female coaches (following the “first come – first served” basis).

| <b>Course fee</b>                 | <b>€300</b> (will be borne by the EHF; in case of late withdrawal the course fee has to be paid – see registration form)  |
| <b>Course package for coaches</b> | <b>€750</b> has to be paid directly to the Camelot Beach Handball Tournament Organisation. Included in the course package are accommodation with full board and transfers between the courts and the hotel.           |
| <b>Travel</b>                     | All participants have to organise the travel and to pay the travel expenses themselves (except WHB support*).   |
| <b>Transfer</b>                   | Will be organised by the organiser free of charge for referees and delegates; coaches have to bear the transfer costs by themselves.  |
